Mysore had been ruled by the Wodeyars who were art and craft connoisseurs. Chamundeshwari temple and Maharaja Palace are some of the most amazing landmarks that you would have seen. Chamundeshwari Temple situated on the Chamundi Hills provides a perfect backdrop you would cherish forever.



Itinerary: Day 01 - 5 Nov 2022

- Pick Up from BMS School of architecture at 7 am.
- We will start our journey to Mysore and enroute have breakfast, later visit to **Channapatana Wood Colony**, Channapatana also known as "the land of toys". Famous for its wooden handicrafts world wide. This town has a rich cultural history and is home to a seasoned artisans practicing their craft from hundreds of years, Channapatna is also called Town of toys ("Gombegala nagara").
- To the next sightseeing spot, the **Tombs of Tipu Sultan** and Hyder Ali. Tipu Sultan had built the graves for his mother Fakhr-Un-Nisa and his father Hyder Ali in 1782-84. After his death, he too was buried in the Gumbaz that is set in the middle of the wonderful garden. Tiger-striped painted walls and lattice windows of the tombs built in Persian style delight its visitors. The amazingly crafted dome is set on a cubical structure and supported by 36 granite pillars. It is said that Tipu Sultan had brought different species of flowers from various countries that including Persia, Kabul, Ottoman Turkey, and French Mauritius.
- Head to the next sightseeing **Tipu Sultan Fort**. The Tipu's Fort which is a prominent landmark of the city of Bangalore depicts intricate Islamic-style architecture. The palace was built by Tipu Sultan and he named it "Rash e Zannat" meaning "Envy of Heavens". The sultan used the palace as a summer retreat and was built completely of teak wood. The palace was opened to the general public in 2005.
- We will head to have **Lunch**.
- Post Lunch we visit **Mysore Maharaja Palace**. Among all the sightseeing spots of our one-day Bangalore to Mysore trip, the most enjoyed stopover is the marvelous Maharaja Mysore Palace. Marvel at the fabulous palace that features several beautiful halls like the Public darbar hall, Gombe Thotti, Private Darbar, and Casket Room. The incredibly fascinating feature of the grandiose palace is the pinkish marble domes. An architectural masterpiece designed by the architect Henry Irwin in 1897 – 1912 reflects a perfect blend of Hindu, Muslim, Gothic and Rajput styles of architecture

- Next Sightseeing **Brindavan Garden**. Witness the marvelous Brindavan Gardens as the next hotspot of our one-day Bangalore to Mysore tour. Visitors would be mesmerized by its picturesque structure. Stunning features of gardens are the musical fountain that allures all guests. The Garden has been laid out as a series of terraces and houses diversified varieties of plants. The delightful garden built by Mysore's diwan, Sir Mirza Ismail is spread over 60 acres of land and is segregated into the main gate area, South Brindavan, Northern Brindavan, and Children's Garden. The most captivating feature of the gardens is the illuminated fountains.
- Later return to Bangalore and on the way Dinner.
- Drop at BMS School of Architecture.
